

**01 REQUIREMENTS**

- You must be eligible for Purchase Referred Care (PRC) at the time of service.
- Applications for alternate resources are available at each FourPoints Health clinic.
- If you need assistance in applying for alt resources contact eligibility Specialist, Megan Johnson at (435) 586-1112 ext. 451.

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**02 SCHEDULING**

- Contact your Optometrist and confirm they accept your insurance and payment from Purchase Referred Care (PRC) for both exam and hardware.
- Schedule an appointment for an evaluation and screening.
- Contact your local FourPoints Health clinic for a PO number prior to your appointment.

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**03 OPTOMETRY VISIT**

- Provide your PO number(s) at the time of your Optometry evaluation and screening.
- Request that a summary of visit to be sent to your local FourPoints Health provider.

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**04 PAYMENT**

- PRC coverage for evaluation and screening maximum is \$75.00.
- PRC coverage for frames and lenses maximum is \$150.00
- Any balance exceeding the amount covered by PRC and your insurance will be the patient's responsibility.
- Often vision centers require payment be made before hardware is ordered. It is important to pay your portion of cost and remind optometrist to fax the remaining bill to the FourPoints Health Business Office at (435) 867-1514.

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**05 IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

- Youth still attending school can receive 1 pair of glasses and an eye exam every year as needed for vision correction.
- Youth with scratched, broken, damaged, or lost glasses may receive a one time replacement at 50% paid by Purchase Referred Care (PRC) and 50% paid by parent/guardian
- Non-Diabetic adults are eligible for glasses and an eye exam every two years
- Diabetic adults are eligible for an annual eye exam and eye wear if recommended by the optometrist.
